

RULES

SCHEDULES

Find your schedule in the [PaddleWar.org](#) player portal

- Once schedules are published, inform your team.
- Get availability for all matches prior to start of season, then update as needed.
- Here is an easy [Excel Scheduler Spreadsheet tool](#) you can use. Please fill it in with the appropriate MATCH DATES and ROSTER INFO.

TEAM FEES

Home Team Match Responsibilities: Court/Guest Fees & New Balls

- Once the schedule has been published, contact your facility & pay court fees.
- Home Team supplies balls, so please purchase new balls for the season.
- Take the total court/guest fees and any amount you will need to purchase balls, and divide that between the number of players on your team. Collect money before start of season.

LINEUPS

6 players required for each match | 2 players required per line (6 players total) (3-line format)
4 players required for each match | 2 players required per line (4 players total) (2-line format)

- Each week you will determine your roster for the matches using available players. It is recommended that you send the roster out a week before the match and have everyone confirm that they can play.
- As the captain, you can determine which players play on which courts for each round. Feel free to mix up the lineup for each round and use the sub if present.

ENTER SCORES

Winning team must enter scores within 48 hours of the match:

- Log into [paddlewar.org](#) (after the match enter your scores via your PaddleWar player portal).

HELPFUL HINTS

- Prior to start of season, schedule practice times with your teammates.
- Weekly drills and/or social play amongst your team is encouraged.
- Watch your local Facebook group page and your email box for upcoming league & event announcements.
- Home team captain will reach out to away Captains at least 2 days prior to inform the opposing team if there are any issues or special information that needs to be shared (ex: no water on courts, limited parking, check in at front desk, we have 2 indoor, 1 outdoor court, etc).
- Bring drinks and snacks for your team (*optional, but a great way to support your players and create a fun team atmosphere*).
